How to Use This Calendar

This calendar is a student-facing overview. LearnDash remains the official location for the exact weekly videos, readings, reflection questions, practices, resources, and any updates.

Weekly Rhythm

- Complete the assigned LearnDash videos and readings.
- Complete Video Reflection & Practice. Choose one of the three practices provided each week.
- Weeks 1-8 also include an Abide Practice focused on personal formation in Christ.
- Participate in the E4:12 Discord community for prayer, encouragement, questions, and interaction.
- Come prepared for the Thursday gathering. Class time emphasizes discussion, modeling, practice, prayer, feedback, and accountability.
- Meet with your spiritual coach regularly and complete the required coach checkpoints.

Current Reading Framework

Use the reading assignments posted in LearnDash. Current course materials include the disciple-making curriculum, Scripture, and the current supporting texts assigned within each phase of the pathway.

Week	Dates	Theme	Focus / Milestone
1	Aug. 28-Sept. 3	Our All-Consuming Mission	Mission of disciple-making; first concrete step; begin observing a disciple-maker.
2	Sept. 4-10	The Missionary Nature of God, Part 1	God as the great Multiplier; ordinary life on mission; complete disciple-maker observation.
3	Sept. 11-17	The Missionary Nature of God, Part 2	Living as a sent one; map where God has placed you; coach identified by end of week.
4	Sept. 18-24	Advancing the Greatest Cause in the Universe	Kingdom allegiance; bring ordinary life under the rule of King Jesus.
5	Sept. 25-Oct. 1	Disciple-Making Defined, Part 1	Clarify disciple-making; confront excuses; pray and labor for spiritual fruit.
6	Oct. 2-8	Disciple-Making Defined, Part 2	Relational, transformational, co-missional, and radical disciple-making.
7	Oct. 9-15	The Disciple-Making Journey	Spiritual parenting; understand where people are and help them take a wise next step.
8	Oct. 16-22	From Vision to Reality	Move from vision to intentional rhythm; establish a 30-day disciple-making step; coach meeting due.

SECTION 2: The Man and the Message - Formation & Fluency | Weeks 9-16

Week	Dates	Theme	Focus / Milestone
9	Oct. 23-29	Jesus Is God on Mission	Behold Christ and understand disciple-making as participation in His mission.
10	Oct. 30-Nov. 5	Maturity Looks Like Jesus	Christlikeness as the goal of discipleship; formation shaped by the gospel.
11	Nov. 6-12	Jesus' Identity, Part 1	Know and delight in the person of Jesus Christ.
12	Nov. 13-19	Jesus' Identity, Part 2	Continue beholding Christ; deepen gospel fluency; coach meeting due.
BREAK	Nov. 26	Thanksgiving Break	No class.
13	Nov. 27-Dec. 3	The Work of Jesus, Part 1	Understand and apply the saving work of Christ.
14	Dec. 4-10	The Work of Jesus, Part 2	Bring the gospel into everyday life, identity, relationships, and obedience.
15	Dec. 11-17	Faith	Living by faith in Christ; coach meeting due.
BREAK	Dec. 24 & 31	Christmas & New Year Break	No class.
16	Jan. 1-7	Repentance	Lifelong repentance as a normal rhythm of following Jesus.

SECTION 3: The Method | Weeks 17-24

Week	Dates	Theme	Focus / Milestone
17	Jan. 8-14	Intensity	Faithful imitation of Jesus; purposeful, whole-life disciple-making.
18	Jan. 15-21	Intentionality	Move from good intentions to deliberate relationships and spiritual investment.
19	Jan. 22-28	Identify	Recognize the people God has already placed around you; coach meeting due.
20	Jan. 29-Feb. 4	Invest	B.L.E.S.S.S.; invest deeply through prayer, listening, shared life, service, and gospel purpose.
21	Feb. 5-11	Invite	Evangelism, gospel conversations, and helping people move toward Christ.
22	Feb. 12-18	Increase, Instruct, Imitate, and Involve	Move converts toward maturity; use the Involvement Ladder; begin the Disciple-Making Action Plan.
23	Feb. 19-25	Intercession: The Way of Prayer	Pray for them, pray with them, teach them to pray; identify My Few; coach meeting due.
24	Feb. 26-Mar. 4	Inflame: Utter Dependency on the Holy Spirit	Clarify what only God can do; identify a primary alongside focus; depend on the Spirit.

SECTION 4: Motivation and Movement | Weeks 25-32

Week	Dates	Theme	Focus / Milestone
25	Mar. 5-11	The Glory of God	Disciple-making for God's glory; sharpen Personal Mission and mission statement.
26	Mar. 12-18	For the Fame of Jesus' Name	Presence: create relational proximity and help people behold Christ.
27	Mar. 19-25	Compelled by Love	Listen: know the person, go deeper, and let Christ's love move you toward others; coach meeting due.
28	Mar. 26-Apr. 1	Joy for You and Others	Truth: help people see, enjoy, trust, and obey Christ.
29	Apr. 2-8	Living in Light of Eternity	Practice: move truth toward concrete obedience with urgency, compassion, and gospel confidence.
30	Apr. 9-15	Love-Fueled Obedience	Model: application, accountability, affirmation, self-denial, and a life worth imitating.
31	Apr. 16-22	A.M.P.E.D.	Authority, Method, Presence, Expectation, Dependency; Mission + Multiply; coach meeting due.
32	Apr. 23-29	Join the Movement	Capstone: complete and refine Action Plan, identify first faithful step, pray, and participate in commissioning.

Disciple-Making Action Plan Progression

Beginning in Week 22, the Action Plan becomes the primary long-range application tool. Students build it gradually rather than completing it in one sitting.

Week	Action Plan Focus	Key Question / Aim
22	Personal Formation + Personal Mission	Who am I becoming, and where has God placed me?
23	My Few	Who might God be calling me to help toward faith or maturity?
24	Primary Focus + Dependency	Whom will I likely walk alongside, and where must I depend on the Spirit?
25	Mission	Sharpen the personal mission statement and missional overlap.
26	Presence	Create regular relational proximity.
27	Listen	Know the person's story, beliefs, fears, desires, and hopes.
28	Truth	Bring Scripture and the gospel naturally into real life.
29	Practice	Move truth toward a specific next step of obedience.
30	Model	Invite others to observe and practice the Christian life with you.
31	Mission + Multiply	Help disciples participate in mission and begin investing in others.
32	Launch	Finalize the plan, set the first 30 days, establish accountability, and begin.

Week 32: Capstone and Commissioning

- Reflect on the most important truths and practices from the 32-week pathway.
- Complete and peer-review the Disciple-Making Action Plan.
- Identify at least one person to evangelize and one person to intentionally disciple.
- Write a specific first faithful step to take within seven days.
- Establish a realistic first 30-day launch plan and accountability.
- Pray together and be publicly commissioned to continue multiplying transformed disciples.
